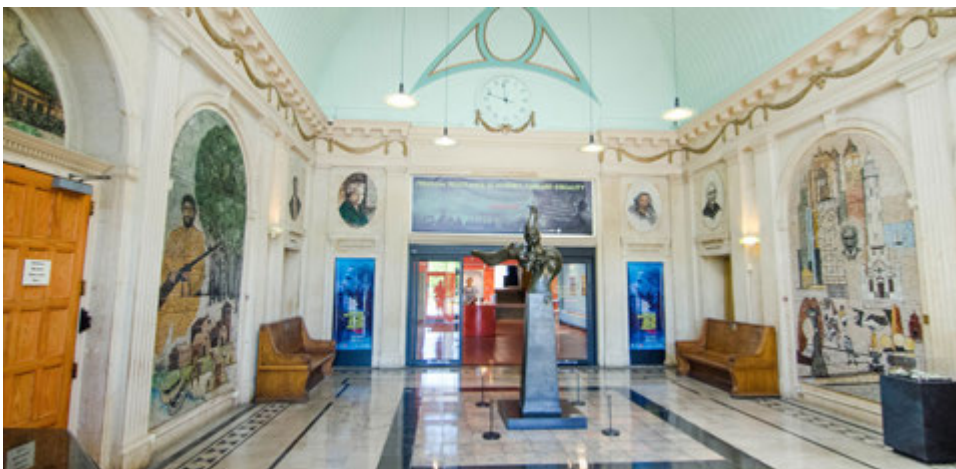
the blessings tree was a success!

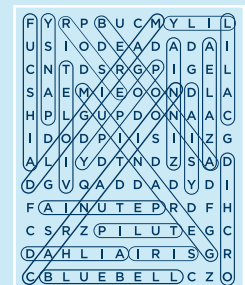
